

On 10 June 1979, at 1338Z a TITAN III-3 rocket was launched from the Cape Kennedy Space Center. The TITAN III-C launch is shown in Figure 1.

Two minutes into the launch, a 450 mile high orbiting DMSP satellite took visual and infrared images of Florida as it passed from south to north.

Close examination of the visual and simultaneous infrared photos revealed the presence of the exhaust trail from the TITAN III-C (see Figure 2) after it was launched from the Air Force complex.




