SPACE SHUTTLE EXHAUST TRAIL EDDIES

On March 13, 1989 at 10:57 EST, the Space Shuttle Discovery was launched from the Cape Kennedy Space Center into the hazy blue sky. The GOES 7 Satellite imagery captured the exhaust cloud eddies caused by horizontal and vertical wind shears.
